- 1. Isaiah 7:14 and Matthew 1:23 (Virgin and Immanuel)
- 2. Micah 5:2 and Matthew 2:6 (Bethlehem)
- 3. Hosea 11:1 and Matthew 2:15 (Flight to Egypt)
- 4. Jeremiah 31:15 and Matthew 2:16-18 (Slaughter of Innocents)
- 5. Isaiah 11:1 and Matthew 2:23 (Branch / Nazarene)
- 6. Isaiah 40:3 and Matthew 3:1-3 (John the Baptist)
- 7. Isaiah 9:1-2 and Matthew 4:15-16 (Messianic Light)
- B. Virgin and Immanuel (Matthew 1:23)
 - 1. Hebrew almāh can mean means "marriageable young woman
 - 2. Septuagint (Greek translation of Hebrew OT) translates almāh as parthenos (virgin maid).
 - 3. Hebrew Emmanuel God with Us first occurs in Isaiah 8:8-10
 - 4. See GENESIS 4:1
 - 5. Christ's HUMAN NATURE comes from the Holy Spirit

I. THE VISIT OF THE WISE MEN (Matthew 2:1-12)

- A. Matthew's Point: Arrival of the Wise Men is a MESSIANIC SIGN
 - 1. ISAIAH 60:3-6
 - 2. **PSALM 72:10**
 - 3. **NUMBERS 24:17**
 - 4. STAR: Probably a conjunction of the planets Saturn and Jupiter in the Constellation of Pisces (the fish - piscatorial).
- B. GOLD, FRANKINCENSE AND MYRRH ... symbolic gifts of faith
 - 1. Isaiah 60:6
 - 2. John 19:38-40
 - 3. The Cross looms over the Cradle
