## WE ARE TRYING SOMETHING NEW THIS YEAR! VBS will be on August 3, 17, and September 7 from Noon – 2 pm.

We are also excited to use our new play structure and new gaga ball pit. With this format, families can choose to stay with their child or drop off. For friends of our church kids, they can come to church with their friend then stay for the fun.
