## WE ARE TRYING SOMETHING NEW

**THIS YEAR!** VBS will be on **August 3, 17, and September 7 from Noon – 2 pm.**

Our VBS has seen fewer kids each year the past few years. In the past, our students have been current church members and friends that they have invited. Very



few people come in "cold" from the community. The only way VBS works for community outreach is for our current kids to invite everyone they know. (which means their parents) Also, those of us without kids can invite neighbors, family, etc. It is on each of us (not just the VBS team but the entire church) to invite people. I know this is different from what we've done the last 20 years or so but the committee that met all agreed that it would be fun to try something new. Once we evaluate this year, we may decide to go back to our traditional VBS but it's kind of exciting for us to try something new and different for a change! We are also excited to use our new play structure and new gaga ball pit. With this format, families can choose to stay with their child or drop off. For friends of our church kids, they can come to church with their friend then stay for the fun.
